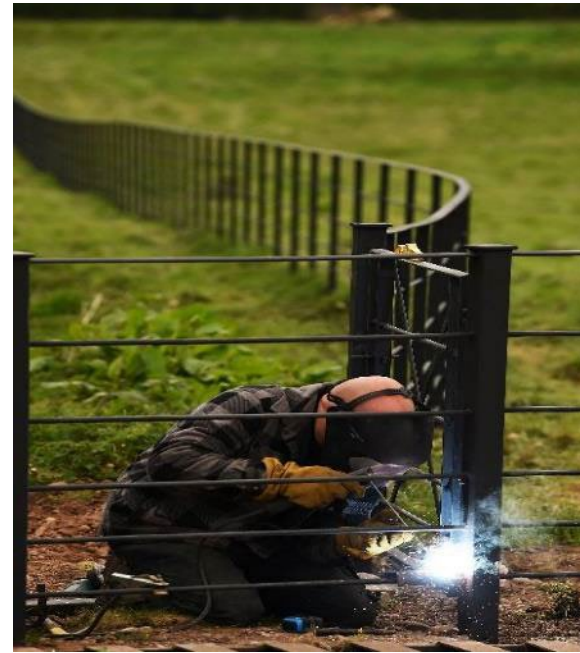




Shugborough Estate : A place of adventure, contemplation & empowerment

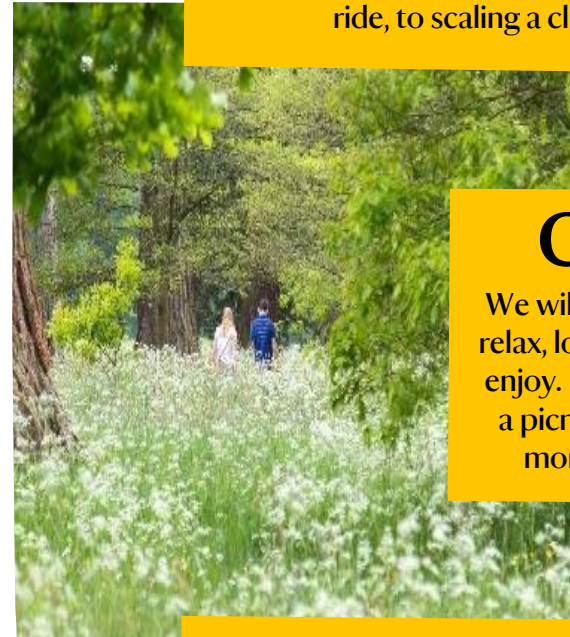
Adventure








Empowerment



